- Flag:

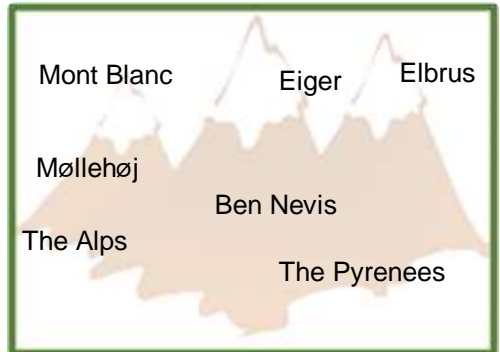


London

- Home of many important museums
- Major river is the Seine with many important bridges
- Main churches of Notre Dame and Sacre Coeur.
