

Remote learning Plan – St Joseph’s Catholic Primary School

Spring Term 1 2021

Timetable

This document outlines the provision being offered to children during the Spring Term for remote learning. Links will be provided for parents and children for each lesson along with work packs for collection for FS2 and Years 1 and Year 2 (see separate message from class teachers)

The expectation is different to the last lockdown, children will be expected to do the home learning activities and the daily practice; for which they all have their log-ins in the books, which were sent out last term. The DFE have outlined expectations for school leaders to ensure work is checked and assessments are carried out. The remote learning will mirror what is happening in school, so no child will get left behind

The expectation is as follows:

Content of the Maths Lesson

The class teacher will provide the work to be completed. Mathematics Mastery is followed across school, concepts already taught will be revisited to help children embed their learning. Teachers will record or use Oak Academy to provide an input for the Maths focus for each day.

In FS2 and KS1 (Year 1 and Year 2) worksheets have been provided for the full 6 weeks of this half term, which mirror the videos on class dojo

Children will be expected to go on 'times tables rockstars' or 'numbots' each day as part of their maths learning

Content for Phonics

The class teacher in FS2 will record a daily phonics lesson for the children to watch at home.

Years 1 and 2 will use recorded lessons supplied by RWInc.

Read Write Inc activities <https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/reading-schemes-oxford-levels/read-writeinc-phonics-guide/> and <https://www.ruthmiskin.com/en/find-out-more/parents/> Teachers will be posting daily activities too linked closely to planned learning within school.

- Stories from YouTube and other sites such as www.booktrust.org.uk and on www.oxfordowl.co.uk linked closely to the text your child is reading in school.

Content for English

The class teacher will record or provide an input for the English focus each day for children to watch or read.

The school uses Spelling Shed for spellings and children will be expected to do this daily

The school uses Bedrock in Key stage 2 for grammar and children will be expected to do this daily

Content for other subjects

A weekly lesson will be provided for one of the foundation subjects dependent on the topic in class

The school curriculum is mapped out against the national curriculum; staff will plan how children could use resources from Oak National Academy to support learning at home.

Science

A weekly science lesson will be provided for children from year 1 upwards

RE

Children in KS2 (year 3 upwards) will be provided with a RE lesson each week

Contact with Teachers

Class bubbles have been created

The teachers will share the work, one week they will be in school teaching the following week they will be responsible for home learning, you will be advised which teacher to contact if you have any problems. Please use class dojo where possible as there will be limited numbers of staff in school.

School has around 50 free sim cards of 30GB data which can be used over 90 days, should you need it for home school learning, please dojo

Log-ins to online learning platforms used in school

The school subscribes to a number of online learning resources, which can be accessed at home and the expectation is that children use these as part of their daily practice (see above)

All logins and passwords have been placed on the inside of the children's home based exercise book and will also be sent via class dojo if needed.

Printed resources

We will print work packs for FS2, year 1 and Year 2 children, these will be available to collect from tomorrow – this will cover 6 weeks of learning.

In KS2 the expectation is that all learning will be done using videos uploaded on class dojo – you will not need to print out resources, children will just record their learning in their books. As the videos are pre-recorded you can access them at anytime of the day.

If you require a paper copy of work, please dojo your child's class teacher

Class Dojo

Every child will have their own portfolio set up on class-dojos and all parents should be connected to their child's class teacher. This will be used as a means of direct communication between the teacher, parent and child.

Teachers will use the class story feature to communicate with the whole class. A message will be posted each morning

Children will be expected to bring their home learning book back to school once lockdown has finished in order for class teachers to assess their work

If you need a new book let your class teacher know

Monitoring Engagement with Remote Education

It is important that children engage with the remote education provided so that they don't fall behind with their learning, however we do acknowledge that each family's home circumstances are unique and there may be factors that affect engagement.

Communication is essential and we would ask that if there are circumstances that mean a child cannot engage at least partially with the remote education that their parent speaks to their class teacher. We can then work together to find a means of support that works for you and your child.
