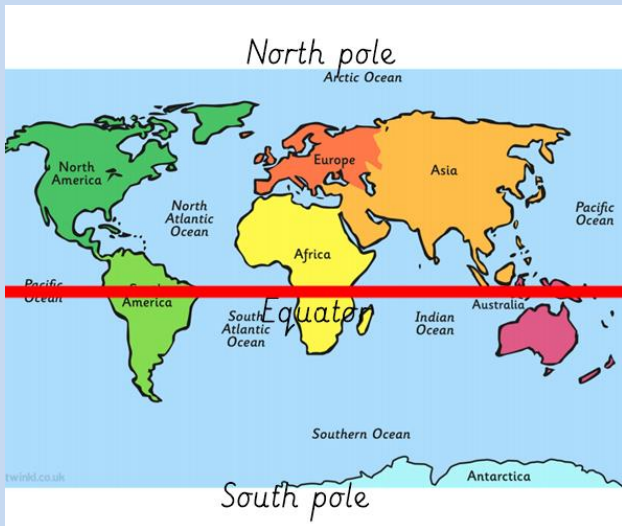


Explorers

Key Knowledge

Earth is made up of land and sea

A continent is a large area of land made up of many countries

There are 7 continents (Asia, Africa, North and South America, Antarctica, Europe and Oceania).

There are 5 oceans (Pacific, North Atlantic, South Atlantic, Indian and Southern).

The South Pole is located in Antarctica at the bottom of the map.

The North Pole is located in the Arctic at the top of a map.

The equator runs through Africa.

The Equator is the warmest place on earth and runs through the middle of a map.
