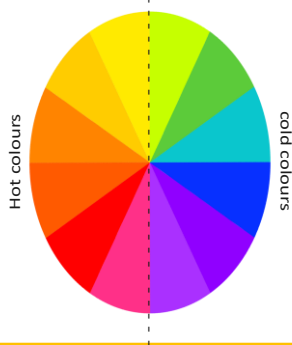


## Explorers - Art

During this half term, Year 2 will learn about hot and cold colours. Inspired by the work of Kandinsky, we will learn to mix various shades and tones of colours to create our own hot and cold landscape painting.

### **Hot and Cold Colours**

We have learnt about hot and cold colours.



### Key Knowledge

There is a colour wheel showing warm and cold colours.

Red, orange, and yellow are hot colours. They make us think of sunny, warm and happy things.

Green, blue and purple are cold colours. They make us think of fresh, calm and chilly things.

You can add water and white paint to colours to make them a lighter tone.

You can add less water and black to make them darker tones.

Wassily Kandinsky was a Russian painter.

He used colour, shade and tones to create feelings.
