

Habitats

During this half term, Year 2 will develop their learning of living things and habitats. They will learn about warm continents and cold continents and how animals are suited to the habitat that they live in. The children will also learn about food chains.

Key Knowledge

Some animals live in continents that are warm and some live in continents that are cold.

Animals in cold continents have lots of fur, feathers or blubber and fatty bodies to help stay warm.

Animals in warmer continents have less blubber and fat in their bodies to keep cool.

Animals are suited to their habitats.

Some living things are consumers and predators.

Some living things are producers.
